How to Find a Great Hotel Deal

After I determine the desired neighborhood or specific location, I usually compare the rates via TripAdvisor, Travelocity.com and Hotels.com. Then, I always check the hotel's web site because it may be the best deal. Finally, I call the hotel and ask if they will match the best deal or offer a lower rate. By booking directly with the hotel or its web site, you can use your "rewards" cards and earn points.

Earn Airline Mileage


