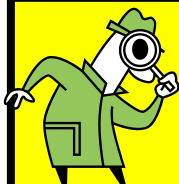

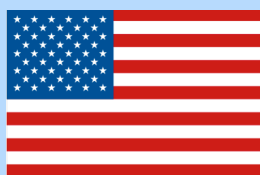

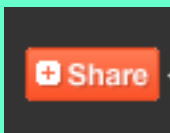
Opinion or Polling Information Needed?
