- **WH Writinghouse**—prepare a citation in Harvard, MLA, APA, or Chicago style
- **Owl Purdue (Online Writing Lab)**—has links to conducting research, using research, APA, MLA and Chicago Style
- **Bibme**—began as a student project at Carnegie-Mellon University and is free

With your local library card in hand, go to your online library web site and search for e-resources, e-learning or electronic resources. Look for FREE access to MANGO languages and choose from 72 different languages to study. Included in the sites are help with conversations and legal affairs, help for librarians and medical staff, and videos and cultural information. MANGO is a great way to start learning English as well, with lessons for speakers of many different languages. You can get guest access without a PIN, but for tracking your lessons you'll need a PIN from your local library.

If your local library doesn't have MANGO, just search for "free online library" in your state or country and sign up for a free library card.
