

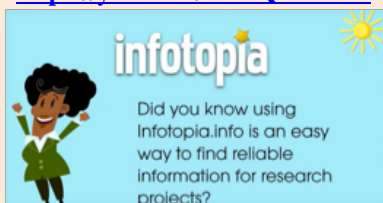

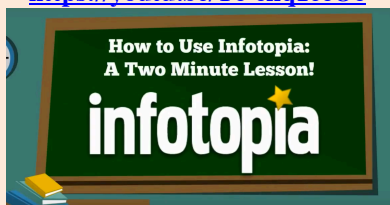

Want to get started learning a foreign language for free? Explore our resources on learning **French, German, Spanish**, and **ESL** (English for Speakers of other Languages.)

Another interesting resource included is **FORVO**, which pronounces words in other languages.

Students often wonder what languages are spoken in various countries around the world. The link to **Infoplease** on this resource indicates all the languages spoken in dozens of countries.

For example, did you know that Singapore's languages include the following: **English** (official) 36.9%, **Mandarin** (official) 34.9%, other Chinese dialects (includes **Hokkien, Cantonese, Teochew, Hakka**) 12.2%, **Malay** (official) 10.7%, and **Tamil** (official) 3.3%.
