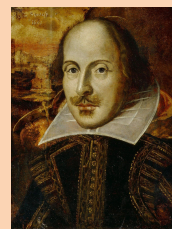

Laura Boyd, in this article from Edutopia, explains how she uses **Genially** to create infographics, games, and more to encourage students' interest in her world language classes.

She uses **infographics** to link to countries and art works around the world. She uses **"escape rooms"** that include puzzles for the students to solve. One escape room was to climb Macchu Picchu and answer questions along the way. At the end, students received a stamp on their passport. It created a lot of interest, cooperation, and competition among the students.

She also creates **presentations** and **interactive images** using Genially.

Genially sounds like an interesting technology tool to promote learning in ALL subjects!
