First, follow the steps of the scientific method to create an award winning and successful project.

1. Ask a question you want to answer.
2. Do background research on the topic.
3. Form a hypothesis.
4. Test your hypothesis by doing an experiment.
5. Analyze your data (results from your experiment).
6. Communicate your results to others.
