



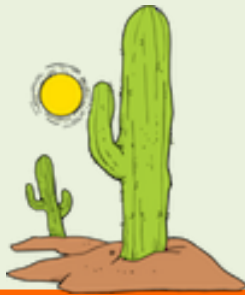
Biomes

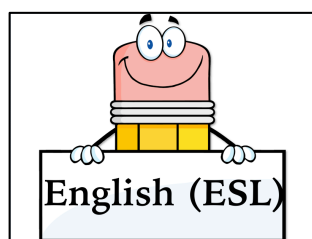

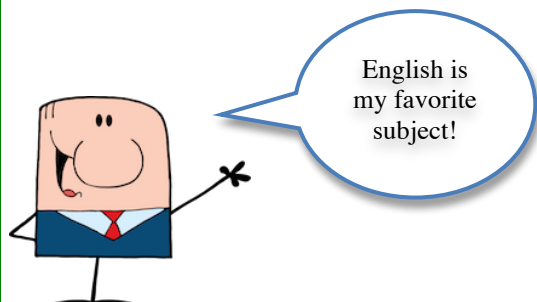

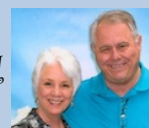
