Are you using Libby yet? You can install Libby on your phone or tablet and borrow ebooks, audiobooks, magazines, and more from your local library for free.

If you belong to several libraries, you can set up all your libraries on Libby and put items on your wish lists, hold lists, and then check them out as they become available.

Advantages:

- You can read across devices
- Never worry about overdue library items again
- You can download your items to read offline or you can read online
- You can listen to audiobooks that you checked out in your car
- If you prefer reading on your Kindle, you can manage your item by checking them out to your Kindle

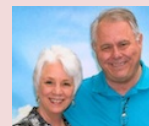
