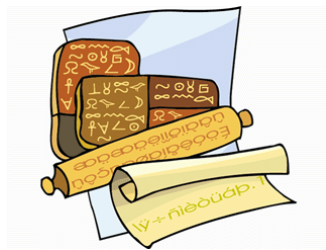

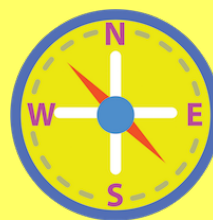
60 Ideas for Using Google MyMaps

Can your students effectively use maps in any subject? Matt Miller, a former Spanish teacher and Google-Certified Innovator, has developed a web site called *Ditch the Textbook* and he has included ways for students to use MyMaps from Google Maps to enhance learning in many subjects. MyMaps allows students (and teachers) to create a customized map that plots historical events, the settings of fictional works, to locate regions where endangered species live, and much, much more.

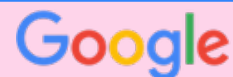
