Have students in your French, Spanish, German, Italian, Portuguese, or English classes locate an article that interests them. Then, share the article with the class by summarizing it in the foreign language and tell a bit about the country and its people.

- What are the physical characteristics of the country?
- What countries and/or bodies of water border the country?
- What seems to be the most important recent headline for this country or city?

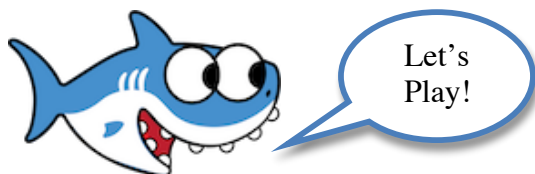

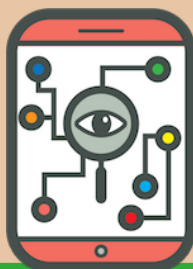
