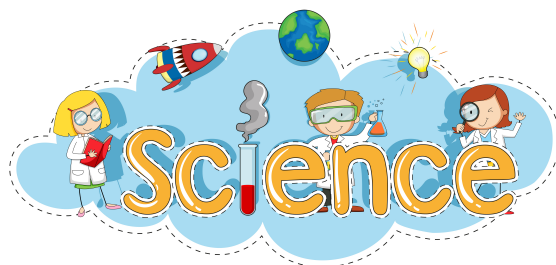

Check out our new Science/Technology images from Kidtopia. They are age-appropriate for grades PK-4.

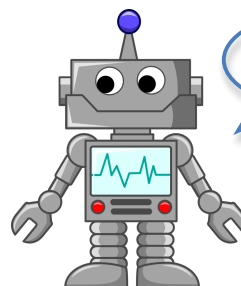
There are nine different links to image libraries such as NASA Kids' Club, Clipart Library, Technology Images and Clipart, Public Domain Science Images and more.

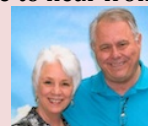
