Some of their reasons include the following:

1. You should always use more than one source for your research.
2. You can't rely on something when the writer is anonymous.
3. On Wikipedia, the writers with an agenda often cancel out the other writers.
4. Sometimes writers can include malicious or incorrect information on certain topics.
5. Anyone with Internet access can edit a Wikipedia article. They don't have to know anything about the subject matter.
