

Virtual Nerd was originally designed as supplemental learning resource for mathematics for middle and high school students. Savvas Learning acquired VirtualNerd in 2013 and made it available for free for students and teachers around the world.

These are videos that students can watch from home to brush up on their skills or to prepare for exams on numerous topics. In each short video, a teacher walks students through the topic using a whiteboard. Just as an example, "Operations with Whole Numbers" includes 32 separate videos for grades 6-8.

Courses available include:

- Grades 6-8 Math (413 videos)
- Pre-Algebra (709 videos)
- Algebra 1 (724 videos)
- Algebra 2 (548 videos)
- Geometry (271 videos)
- Common Core Math (1400 videos for Grades 1-12)
